

Higashi Ward Recyclables

We collect recyclable garbage at recycle boxes located at nine public facilities in Fukuoka City, as well as local community collection boxes and local community group collections (such as used paper collections by children's clubs and local communities), or shopfront collections at supermarkets, electronics stores and other stores. Collection locations differ depending on the item. Check the website for your closest collection location.

Used paper

Recycle boxes at public facilities, local community collection stations or community group collections.

Separate used paper into the three types below and bind the piles crosswise with twine.

Newspapers (Leave advertisements inside.)





Paper waste (magazines and other paper)



What is paper waste

Recyclable paper items not including newspapers and cardboard boxes, such as sweet boxes and envelopes


Paper Waste

○ Paper sweet boxes, etc. ○ Tissue boxes ○ Books and school printouts

○ Cling film tubes and toilet paper tubes ○ Flyers ○ Envelopes \bigcirc Postcards \bigcirc Pamphlets \bigcirc Books \bigcirc Paper bags \bigcirc Magazines

You can recycle paper regardless of its thickness or size. You can even recycle small price tags.

Remove any plastic.

Items that cannot be disposed of as paper waste


O Plastic coated paper O Thermal paper (such as fax paper and receipts)

O Carbon paper (such as shipping labels)

O Scented paper (such as packaging for washing powder and incense)

Oily paper (such as pizza boxes or paper with crayon on) O Photographs

Separate newspapers and cardboard boxes from other paper waste and tie them into individual piles.





Disposing of Paper Waste in 3 steps

Step ① Collect paper waste in paper bags.

Any paper bag* is acceptable.

Use any paper bag* you have in your home.

*Be sure to remove any fabric or plastic handles.

Step 2 Close the paper bag.

Be sure the paper doesn't fall out when it's collected. Tie with string or staple together.

You can also just tie magazines together with a cross.





Take the waste to used paper local community group collections or recycle stations.

You can also take it to recycle stations just like newspapers and cardboard boxes. △This process is not the same as regular garbage collections. You cannot dispose of them at your apartment complex designated waste area.
