




With long history and tradition various traditional crafts have been developed and passed down from generations to generations in this region. Hakata Ori, (woven textile) Hakata ningyo (dolls) and other traditional crafts are still loved by locals in Fukuoka City. You can see all these traditional crafts in various locations in the city.





Hakata Ningyo are multi-colored earthware dolls produced in Fukuoka Prefecture. It is said that Hakata Ningyo were first made about 400 years ago when craftsmen of Japanese roof tile were gathered to build Fukuoka Castle. The unglazed dolls made of clay by the craftsman is believed to be the origin of Hakata Ningyo. Today, several forms of dolls are being made including Bijin-mono (dolls of beautiful lady), the most well-known genre of Hakata Ningyo.

Tokugawa shogunate the name of Hakata Kenjyo was born (Kenjyo means "present"). The firmness of Hakata-obi (kimono sash) receives high reputation. The obi made with this fabric produces a distinctive squeaking sound when being tightened, so the obi tied in the morning is said not to come loose until evening. Recently, wallets, pouches, and business cards holds made from Hakata-ori have become popular souvenirs.



Aside from Hakata-ori and Hakata Ningyo, Fukuoka is known for a wealth of attractive crafts, including Hakata Basami (scissors), Hakata magemono,(woodenware), Hakata koma (toy top), Hakata Hariko and Multi-Glass, all of which are designated as local special folk crafts by the Fukuoka Prefectural Governor. You can see these great works at each shop, Hakata HAKATA TRADITIONAL CRAFT AND DESIGN MUSEUM as well as Hakatamachiya Furusatokan.
