

COVID-19 Vaccination Program

Free

- Residents aged between **6 months old** and **4 years old** have been sent this notification.
- You can book your child's vaccination appointment when you have received this notification.
- Your child will be given **3 doses** of the Pfizer vaccine for infants.

What is in this envelope:

- Your child will be given 3 doses of the COVID-19 vaccination, but only the vaccination tickets and pre-vaccination questionnaires for the 1st and 2nd doses are enclosed. **The third dose vaccination ticket and pre-vaccination questionnaire will be sent after completing the 1st dose.**

① Your child's vaccination ticket

You need this vaccination ticket **when you book your child's vaccination appointment** and **when they get vaccinated**. The vaccination ticket has an adhesive back. Take their vaccination ticket to the vaccination appointment and **do not remove the backing**.

② Two pre-vaccination questionnaires

Two pre-vaccination questionnaires are enclosed in this envelope. Take **one questionnaire to each of your child's vaccination appointments**.

Check the translation of the questionnaire on the Ministry of Health, Labour and Welfare website when filling in your child's questionnaire. Take the completed questionnaire to your child's vaccination appointment. The translated questionnaire is for reference purposes only. You cannot use it at your child's appointment.

How to book a vaccination appointment

- You must **book** your child's vaccination appointment using their vaccination ticket number either online or by calling the call center below.

Vaccination ticket number

The vaccination ticket number (券番号) is a 10-digit number on the left part of the vaccination ticket enclosed in this envelope. The number is the same for all three doses.

1. Book via the website

- ⚠ Your child's default password is their date of birth.
Example: 20201231
- ⚠ Go to the Fukuoka City vaccination reservation site to check available vaccination sites and time slots.

- ## 2. Book via the call center dedicated to the infant vaccination program
- Tel: 092-510-9361 Lines open: 8:30-17:30

Cautionary notes

- Intervals between doses for the infant vaccination doses are different:
 - The 2nd dose will be given **3 weeks after the 1st dose.**
 - The 3rd dose will be given **8 weeks after the 2nd dose.**
- The same type of vaccine will be used for all 3 doses. The same vaccine will still be used if your child turns 5 years old before receiving the 3rd dose.
- The COVID-19 vaccine can be given at the same time as the flu vaccine. However, for any vaccines other than the flu vaccine, you must leave a 2-week interval between your child's COVID vaccination and the other vaccine.

What to bring on the day of your child's vaccination

- **A parent or legal guardian must accompany their child** to their vaccination appointment. If a parent or guardian cannot accompany their child for unavoidable reasons, they can delegate other family members who are familiar with the child's health conditions to accompany them. They must have a letter of authorization from the child's parent or guardian.
- You must bring the following to your child's vaccination appointment.
 - ① Vaccination ticket
 - ② Completed pre-vaccination questionnaire
 - ③ Personal identification documents for both the child and their accompanying adult
(e.g. Residence card, passport, health insurance card, My Number card)
 - ④ Mother and child health handbook
 - ⑤ Letter of authorization (where applicable)

- Your child cannot get their vaccination without their vaccination ticket.
- **Fill out the pre-vaccination medical questionnaire before** taking your child to their vaccination appointment.
- Ensure that your child wears clothes that **allow them to show their upper arm** on the day of their vaccination.

If vaccinated outside of Fukuoka City

- If your child has already been vaccinated outside of Fukuoka City, but you want them to have their second or third dose in Fukuoka City, call the COVID-19 Vaccination Call Center

Same day cancellations waste vaccines

Do not cancel on the day of your child's vaccination unless your child or any accompanying adult shows signs of illness.

- Vaccinations can on extremely rare occasions cause adverse health effects. Therefore, the *Relief System for Health Complications Caused by Vaccination* is in place in Japan. Contact your local municipality for information on how to use this system.

Preventing the spread of COVID-19

Be careful of the 5 situations that increase the risk of infection:

- 1) Social gatherings with alcohol
- 2) Eating or drinking in large groups for extended periods
- 3) Talking without a mask
- 4) Communal living in confined spaces
- 5) Switching locations
