


# 3 Your account at a bank/financial institution

# You must agree to the following points

- ① I meet all the requirements described on this form.
- ② Neither I nor any members of my household are subject to tax treaties.
- 3 Neither I nor any members of my household have received the monetary relief of 70,000 yen under this scheme.
- I give my consent to Fukuoka City to check my personal information to verify the information I have given in this form. I also consent to the city to do so in response to request from other municipalities.
- (5) I will submit any additional documents upon request from Fukuoka City.
- 6 I understand that my application will be deemed to have been withdrawn if it is incomplete and not corrected by the due date set by the city.
- I understand that any documents I submit cannot be returned.
- I understand that I will not receive the monetary relief if, for some reason, the payment cannot be made after Fukuoka City has decided to pay the monetary relief and the reason is not resolved by May 31, 2024.
- If I am found to have provided any erroneous or false information in the form, I will return the monetary relief that I have received.

You must submit the following documents by Tuesday, April 30, 2024.

(Before you submit your application, check if you have all necessary documents.)

- ☐ Your completed application form (this form)
- $\square$  A copy of personal identification of the head of household (e.g. a copy of My Number card (front side only),

driver's license or residence card)

- ☐ A copy of your bank/financial account book or cash card of the bank/financial account you choose
- □ Certificate of exemption from residence tax for FY2023 if you have ticked □国内 in Section 2
- □ Document proving the date of your entry into Japan (e.g. a copy of your passport or residence card) if you have ticked □海外 in Section 2
- ☐ If you are applying or receiving the payment on behalf of someone else:
  - 1 A copy of the representative's personal identification
  - 2 A copy of a document proving the representative's relationship to the head of household
