# Cruise Ships Firstly Called at Hakata Port

# (1) The maiden call by Celebrity Millennium

On Thursday, February 19th, 2015, a cruise ship, Celebrity Millennium firstly called at Hakata. The ship operated by Celebrity Cruises, a premium-class cruise line of Royal Caribbean Cruises Limited brought Fukuoka City some 1,500 guests mainly from China.
