Maiden Call of Quantum of the Seas

On Saturday, June 27th, 2015, Quantum of the Seas, the largest cruise ship ever allocated in Asian market made the first call to Hakata Port. The cruise ship boasts the largest gross tonnage and passenger capacity among cruise ships ever called to Hakata or Japan. Some 4,450 passengers, mainly from China visited Fukuoka and enjoyed sightseeing.

Quantum of the Seas is the second largest cruise ship in the world and a new ship that has just started service in November, 2014. To commemorate the maiden call, Hakata Port held a welcome ceremony on board. Fukuoka City and many related parties including the Ministry of Land, Infrastructure, Transport and Tourism, Kyushu Cruise Promotion Conference and Hakata Port Promotion Association attended the ceremony and welcomed the ship. When the ship arrived at the port, a Japanese musical band, Japan Marvelous gave a welcome performance.
