Relief Fund for Ukrainian Humanitarian Crisis: Donation Boxes Set Up Around Fukuoka City

Fukuoka City has announced it has set up donation boxes in the locations below to help support the response to the humanitarian crisis in Ukraine and efforts in countries hosting refugees displaced from Ukraine.

1) Period donation boxes will be in place

Thursday March 10, 2022 to Tuesday May 31, 2022

- City Hall
Everyday between 9:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.
(City Hall opens at 8:00 a.m. on March 10 only.)
- Ward Offices and Branch Offices
Weekdays between 9:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m.
- Fukuoka City International Center
Weekdays between 9:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.

You can film and report from the donation box area in the City Hall.
From 8:00 a.m. on Thursday, March 10
North Entrance of the City Hall (Best Denki side)

2) Donation boxes are located in 12 locations around the city

- City Hall (North Entrance and South Entrance)
- Ward Offices and Branch Offices
- Fukuoka City International Center (4-1 Tenya-machi, Hakata-ku)

3) All donations will be sent to

Japan Red Cross Society (Relief Fund for Ukrainian Humanitarian Crisis)

- When transferring your donations to the Japan Post Bank
 - *You will be exempt from handling fees if the transfer is processed in person at a branch office of the Japan Post Bank. However, handling fees will be charged if the transfer is made through an ATM or internet banking.
 - *If you would like a receipt, write your name, address, telephone number and that you want a receipt in the comment section of the payment slip.

- When transferring your donations to the Mitsui Sumitomo, Mitsubishi UFJ or Mizuho Banks.
 - *You may be charged handling fees.
 - *You must register in advance if you would like a receipt for your donation.
