Support for People Fleeing Ukraine (1st Update)

The preparations to support people fleeing to Fukuoka City from Ukraine have been completed, so the latest information will be regularly updated.

The Fukuoka City Government will continue to investigate what support measures can be taken in addition to the support provided by the Government of Japan.

1. Housing support

- Applications for municipal housing will begin to be accepted from April.
- Applications are accepted anytime for private housing (free use of housing provided by Apaman Co., Ltd.). Consultation required for location and size.

2. Temporary accommodation until moving in to supported housing

- Cooperating hotels within Fukuoka City will provide rooms free of charge.
