Support for People Fleeing Ukrainian (2nd Update)

The following is an updated summary on the support available in Fukuoka City for refugees from Ukraine as of May 24.

1. Number of refugees in Fukuoka City 11 households (20 people)

2. Number of consultations

- Fukuoka City Consultation Support Center for Foreign Residents:
 38 consultations from 13 people
- Fukuoka City Hall (International Affairs Department):
 23 consultations from 12 people

3. Housing support

- The Fukuoka City Consultation Support Center for Foreign Residents has been accepting applications for housing support as of April 1.
- 10 municipal housing facilities have been made available so far.

As of Wednesday, May 25, 1 tenant is scheduled to move in to municipal housing.

Tenant: 1 family of 4 people (parents and children, 2 males and 2 females)

Housing type: Fukuoka city municipal housing

Media coverage

To ensure the privacy of the tenants and their surrounding neighbors, Fukuoka City will not disclose the location of the municipal housing. If you wish to interview the family, an interpreter and other services will be provided, so contact the Fukuoka City International Affairs Department first using the details below.

Private housing provided with city support
 Where necessary, Fukuoka City is introducing free housing provided by private companies supporting this initiative.
