

Support for Evacuees Fleeing Ukraine (3rd Update)

Fukuoka City announced that from Monday, August 8, Ukrainian evacuee support staff will be stationed at the Fukuoka City Consultation Support Center for Foreign Residents, which is managed by the Fukuoka City International Foundation, to provide more extensive support for evacuees fleeing Ukraine.

See below for the latest information on the current support for evacuees.

1. Information on Ukrainian evacuee support staff

Since April, Ukrainian nationals living in Fukuoka City have been volunteering to provide consultation support twice a week for 2 hours a time. However, from August 8, Ukrainian evacuee support staff (Ukrainian nationals living in the city) will be stationed at the Fukuoka City Consultation Support Center for Foreign Residents to provide consultation support. The staff will also provide assistance with: accepting Ukrainian evacuees into Fukuoka, daily life, Japanese language, referrals to related organizations, and other extensive support.

2. Number of evacuees in Fukuoka City (as of August 4)

14 households (26 people)

3. Number of consultations (as of August 4)

- Fukuoka City Consultation Support Center for Foreign Residents:
50 consultations from 20 people
- Fukuoka City Hall (International Affairs Department):
37 consultations from 20 people

4. Housing support

- Housing support applications
The Fukuoka City Consultation Support Center for Foreign Residents started accepting applications for housing support on April 1.
- Municipal housing provision
Ten locations are currently available.
- Number of people housed
Three families totalling eight people
- Private housing provision
Where necessary, Fukuoka City is introducing free housing provided by private companies supporting this initiative.

5. Donations (as of July 29)

A total of 9,912,955 Japanese yen has been raised.
