



HAKATA

Like Tenjin, Hakata is also one of the most concentrated commercial and office areas in Kyushu. It is a hub for wide-area public transportation, including railroads and buses, and has accessibility to all parts of Kyushu. It has many local resources such as temples, shrines, traditional crafts, and festivals, which are well harmonized with urban functions.





Business Hub of Asia


The city is the closest metropolis in Japan to Asia and has a well-developed transportation network. Urban functions such as commerce and business, as well as land, sea, and air transportation hubs, are compactly concentrated in the area with easy access. In addition, the risk of earthquake damage is comparatively low, which reduces the risk of simultaneous damage with the Tokyo area.
