

- Aluminium cans
- Steel cans



- Umbrellas
- Fluorescent tubes

Items should be no more than 1 meter long and 5 centimeters in diameter.



- Aerosol cans

Ensure the can is completely empty. (No need to make holes in the can.)



- Glass
- Broken glass bottles



Glass bottles that are not broken should be disposed of as **Glass Bottles and PET Bottles**.

- Metalware
- Small home appliances

The city does not collect air conditioners, TVs, refrigerators, freezers, washing machines, clothes dryers or personal computers.



- Porcelain & ceramics
- Dry cell batteries
- Gardening soil

Glass Bottles and PET Bottles

- PET bottles are marked with the  symbol. Plastic bottles that only display the  should be disposed of as **burnable garbage**.

- Empty glass bottles for drinks, foods, etc.

Dispose of broken glass bottles as **non-burnable garbage**.



Any item that is too large or too heavy to fit into the designated Fukuoka City garbage bags is classed as **oversized garbage**.
